This Sunday is our **Worship in Action Sunday**. We will gather at our usual 9:30 a.m. summer worship time, have a shorter corporate Worship service, followed by a shorter Fellowship time, and then disperse into the community for our *Acts of Service*.

Groups will leave our building just after 10:30 a.m. The duration of the time spent in service will vary, but most will be accomplished within a couple of hours. Some less.

There will be:
